

## GROUP LEADERS MEETING

- Check In:
  - 1 Please let your players know that they are expected to check in a minimum of 20 minutes prior to their tee time. Players should be ready to be loaded up on their carts 10 minutes before play.
  
- Central Tee Times:
  - 1 Please do not turn your rosters in until the day before your scheduled day to play. This will help with any last minute changes you might have.
  - 2 Fairfield Glade reserves the right to pair single players with your group. If you turn in your rosters with threesomes there is a possibility that a single will be paired with your group. Once your roster has been turned in it is your responsibility to check with CTT or the course before you fill any open spots. Remember those spots may have been filled with single players. Don't show up the morning of play and tell them you have filled your open spots as they may not still be open.
  - 3 Please make sure you have updated your player list with proper player names. Not nick names.
  - 4 If you need an extra time you need to check with CTT prior to the 5 day call in period.
  
- Rain Checks:
  - 1 If you have completed hole #5 you will not be given a rain check if you are playing 9 holes.
  - 2 If you have completed hole #5 you will be given a 9 hole rain check if you are playing 18 holes.
  - 3 If you have completed hole #14 you will not be given a rain check if you are playing 18 holes.
  - 4 There are no cash refunds.
  - 5 Rain checks are only redeemable for green fees and hold no cash value.
  - 6 Rain checks are valid for two years.
  - 7 Rain checks may be added together. Example; two 9-hole rain checks to make up an 18 hole round.
  - 8 This policy is being abused right now and is under review.
  
- Private Coolers – Please remind your players that private coolers are not allowed.
  
- Golf Carts – Golf Carts are not allowed in the parking lots prior to your round of golf. You are welcome to take them into the lots after your round. Please remind your players to be careful when driving a cart in the lot.
  
- Loyalty Program – We have started a loyalty program this season. Players will receive loyalty dollars for all golf related purchases plus green fees. It is very important for all players to carry their Fairfield Glade Community Club photo ID with them, so we can make sure we are getting the dollars on the right member number.
  
- Pace of Play – We are continuing with “Ready Golf”, but have added a time requirement to each round of golf. Please read and share with your group the pace of play policy for the 2010 golf season. As a reminder this 4 ½ hour round is a guideline and most groups should be able to play faster than this.
